Our new Executive Director of the LP, Carla Howell, will be discussing how she will use her political and marketing skills and experiences to advance LP candidates and our cause. State coordinators for three of the LP's Presidential candidates are addressing our convention for 10 minutes each, asking for your support. Joe Seehusen returns, this time as banquet speaker.

Do you have a desire to run for office, or thought about it? We will be running candidates for the U.S. House and Senate this November. We have until June 1 to get candidates on the ballot, so please contact me as soon as possible. We will also be nominating candidates at the convention.

Are you planning on attending the national LP convention the first weekend in May in Las Vegas, NV? To serve as a delegate, you need to attend the Central Committee meeting portion of the convention. The MdLP is allocated 20 delegates, and I have already been contacted by 10 people who want to be selected. If you want to be a delegate and can't attend the CC meeting, please contact me. Even if you aren't selected as a delegate, you can be an alternate. Frequently alternates are able to be seated in other state delegations who don't have a complete group.

Pat Hussey of the Baltimore *Campaign for Liberty* will have liberty-oriented books for sale at the convention, and is generously donating the proceeds to the state party!

And the state convention always offers good food and the enjoyable company of your fellow libertarians! The prices are still the same. We do our best to keep down the costs so as many people as possible can attend without the party taking a loss. I am looking forward to seeing you there!

#### **Editor's Note**

For this issue, we are also printing and mailing newsletter copies to non-MdLP, but National LP members in the state. The various memberships are often confusing –

<u>National LP</u>: being a sustaining National LP member is great, but is separate from the *Maryland* party. Campaign reform legislation (McCain/ Feingold) made it impossible for us to continue combined memberships.

Maryland LP (MdLP): We are the *local state group* which publishes this newsletter, has meetings, events, provides outreach booths, etc. We are in your community. Annual dues is \$20.

Maryland State Central Committee (CC): the CC is the legal entity approved by the Board of Elections. We provide the "Libertarian" party status for candidates on the ballot; our existence permits the LP Presidential nominee to run in Md. CC members must be MdLP members; must be registered Libertarian in Md.; and state their agreement with the non-aggression principle. They are the *voting* members of the state party and put statewide candidates on the ballot at meetings (we don't have primary elections). There is no additional cost. There are also *county* LP organizations which operate under the auspices of the state CC.

<u>Registered Libertarians</u>: any state resident who registers to vote may choose to be registered as a Libertarian. There is no requirement to belong to any of the above organizations, and there are no dues. As of December 31, 2011 the state count is 9,753.

We are talking to you! We really, really want you to join the MdLP (send in the back page form, or click the credit cards on the webpage to join). Become a CC member if so inclined. It would be great if you also join the National LP (www.LP.org). We really, really want you to encourage others to register Libertarian (get a form at the Post Office or the website). Those currently registered as unaffiliated are prime targets. When we get 1% of the state registered, we can stop collecting petition signatures every four years. Come to our upcoming convention and meet likeminded neighbors.

He is currently the President & CEO Liberty Guard, Co-Chair of Americans For Prosperity Baltimore County, Corporate Advisory Board College of Business and Econom-

ics at Longwood University, Business Owner/Operator, Host Straight Talk Radio 1570 KMCD, Vanderbilt University Alumni, Calvert Hall Alumni. Married with two children living in Maryland. Joe has been involved in the liberty movement for many years, serving with different groups, and has a long and varied history. Come hear his views on the current state of liberty in our country and what is the possibility of freedom in our lifetime.

Carla Howell is the new National Libertarian Party Executive Director; Founder, Center for Small Government; Spokesperson and champion for two statewide End the Income Tax ballot initiatives in Massachusetts (almost one million votes each time) as well as a statewide ballot initiative to roll back the Massachusetts sales tax from 6.25% to 3% in 2010, which won



just shy of one million votes. She has appeared on O'Reilly Factor, Neil Cavuto, Glenn Beck, and Fox Business News Happy Hour as well as hundreds of TV interviews and debates since 1998; hundreds of radio interviews including shows hosted by Neal Boortz, Larry Elder, and Michael Medved. Ms. Howell garnered 12% of the vote as Libertarian U.S. Senate candidate against Ted Kennedy in 2000: the highest percentage in party history for a Libertarian U.S. Senate candidate in a 3-way race. She ran for Governor of Massachusetts in 2002 and State Auditor in 1998, appearing in numerous TV debates against Mitt Romney Robert Reich, and other high-profile Democrats. Two-term Massachusetts LP State Chair (1997-1999) and twenty years private sector experience in product/project management, marketing, software development. MBA 1985, Marketing and Entrepreneurship, Babson College, Wellesley, Massachusetts.
