Chair's Report



Be sure to attend the annual Maryland Libertarian Party spring convention, being held at Squire's Italian Restaurant in Dundalk on Saturday, March 14. Our guest speaker will be the Libertarian Party of Virginia two-time statewide candidate Robert Sarvis.

Mr. Sarvis has several achievements as a Libertarian Party candidate:

- He raised over \$300,000 in his two campaigns, and attracted the attention of an independent political action committee, the Purple PAC, which spent another six figures on ads, particularly in the expensive Northern Virginia media market.
- He received unprecedented media attention for an LP candidate, including appearances on MSNBC and CNN, and interviews with the Washington Post, Fox News, and Slate and Reason magazines.
- He garnered over 200,000 votes in his two campaigns, and obtained the third-best percentage for an LP gubernatorial candidate in the history of the party.
- And he organized petition drives in his two races of at least 10,000 signatures each to get on the ballot. In Virginia, a statewide non-establishment candidate must submit 10,000 signatures, with 100 minimum from each of the 11 congressional districts. He also helped get seven LPVA U.S. House candidates on the ballot in 2014, each requiring 1,000 signatures to be collected.

If you are thinking about running for office, you will want to find out how Rob accomplished these things. If you are interested in organizing candidates or a local group, you can also learn from

Further, you can find out what Rob has learned from his two significant races, what he would do again if he ran for office, do differently, and what he sees down the road for the Libertarian Party and the libertarian movement in general.

Squire's Italian Restaurant is conveniently located just outside Baltimore, minutes away from I-95.
