Libertarian candidate for Governor, Susan Gaztañaga, will have an information table at the Greenbelt Labor Day Festival, Information Day, at the Roosevelt Center on Saturday, September 4, 2010 from 10:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. The following day, Sunday, September 5, 2010, she will be the featured speaker at a meeting 6 p.m. at Phillips-Kleiner VFW Post 5627, 5051 Branchville Road, College Park.

Gaztañaga recently appeared on WBAL Radio's Ron Smith show, where she said that she was counting on whoever wins the Democrat and Republican primaries to "do the right thing" and include her in any debates they have, along with any other gubernatorial candidates who qualify to be on the ballot in the general election.
